Vestmannaeyjar Island & IBV

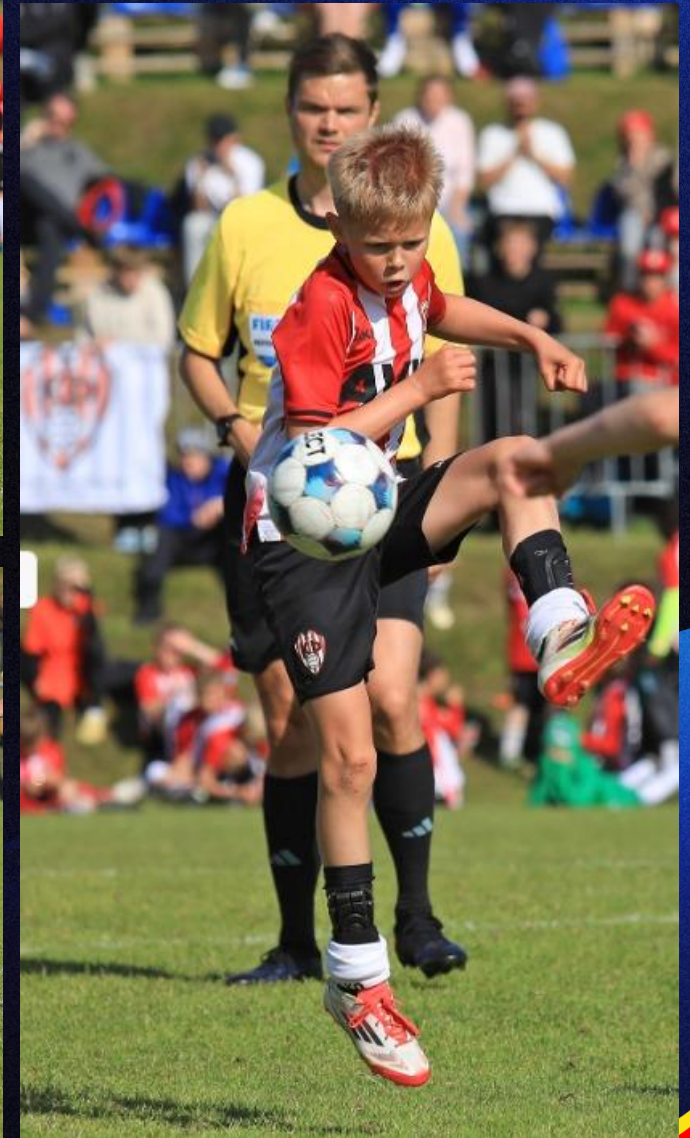


- Vestmannaeyjar is a volcanic archipelago located off the south coast of Iceland
 - One of the largest *Atlantic puffin colonies* in the world nests on the island's sea cliffs
 - The largest island, Heimaey, has a population of 4,414
